Financial Update

The Resources Board gave a financial update last week. Some highlights:

Giving trends at Elora United since 2000

- We have 14% few supporting households giving today than we did in 2000 (including a loss of 20+ since 2014).
- The average household annual giving has increased from \$590 to \$1010.
- Year-over-year giving growth is very sporadic which makes our budgeting a complicated process. (some years we have given -2% to while others we have increased giving by+11%).

This Year (so far)

- We are \$8,000 off our plan for givings.
- We have given 7% less than at this time last year.
 - Oktoberfest revenue was lower than budget.
- We are down 4 families on PAG (which will impact givings by at least \$300/month).

Looking to Next Year

- We will be starting the year with fewer supporting households.
- We will be paying a larger portion of our shared expenses with Bethany United.
 Our surplus will be gone.
- The average 2016 household gift won't be enough to make 2017 budget (by \$100 per household).

We share these numbers so that everyone in our congregation can think and reflect on them. This update comes in the middle of our *Called to Be EloraUC* stewardship conversation. If you have not yet looked over your Stewardship package please do so. Thank you for bringing back the "Response Form" on November 20, so we can celebrate all the givings of time and resources that we share with the church. (If you can't make it to worship on November 20, please drop it in the mail.)

Look for another update from the Resources board in early 2017. As always thank you for your support and generosity to Elora United.


