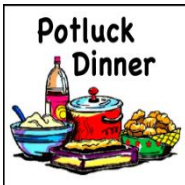

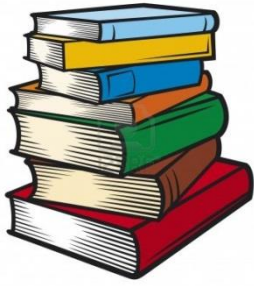

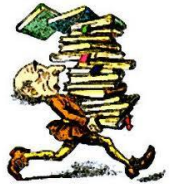
...the telling of lies
