Special Gifts Grants. Our congregation set up the Special Gifts Fund in 1989. It receives donations, usually from estate bequests and memorial gifts. We invest these, and then grant a large proportion (90% of the gifts and growth) to projects.

These projects can be in four areas:

- 1) Capital Improvements: Building/renovation programs for Elora United Church property.
- 2) Education: Lay training to enable members of the congregation to grow in Christian service.
- 3) Community Outreach: Support for projects in our area that help people with spiritual and/or economic needs.
- 4) Projects of the United Church of Canada. These may be projects in Canada or elsewhere, including special appeals. It is over and above regular offerings to Mission and Service.

Funds will be equally disbursed to each project area over a three-year period. (Extra money was given for “capital improvements” a while ago, so no grants can be made to that area until the areas are back in balance.)

Each of these 3 areas has \$644 to grant in 2018. Grants can be made at springtime and the year’s end. So our Mission Board is proposing these grants.

- a) **Revitalize our Church Library – \$644 (Education)**
- b) **Two Countries One World – \$324 (UCC projects)**
– \$320 was already given in the spring.
- c) **Centre Wellington Mission Network – \$500 (Outreach)**

You’ll find information about these posted in the Welcome Centre. If you have any questions or concerns about these grants, please speak with Carole Kennedy, Beverly Bond or Greg Smith-Young. The Mission Board is meeting on January 8, when it will make final decisions.
