Bruce Walker is an advocate, lawyer and blogger who has traced homophobia from its origins, through European criminal law to the present, including the impact on indigenous societies in Canada. The criminal law has been the cornerstone of oppression of sexual minorities. This theme is brought forward through partial decriminalization of homosexuality in 1969, the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms in 1985, and the Apology in the House of Commons in 2017.
